TUBERCULOSIS IMMUNIZATION COVERAGE

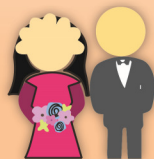

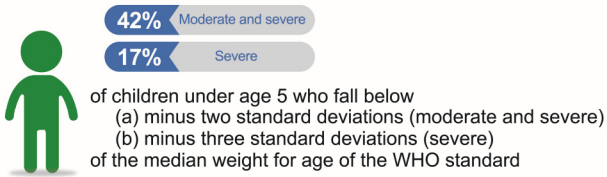

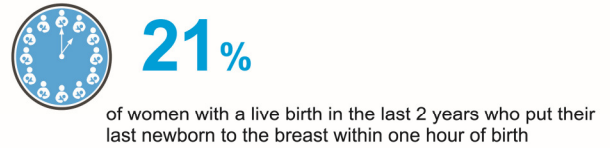

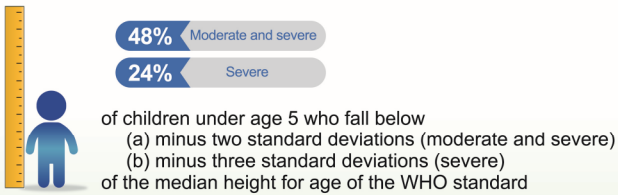

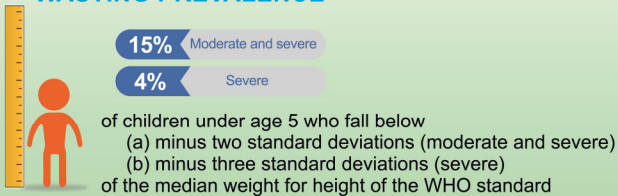

EXCLUSIVE BREASTFEEDING UNDER 6 MONTHS



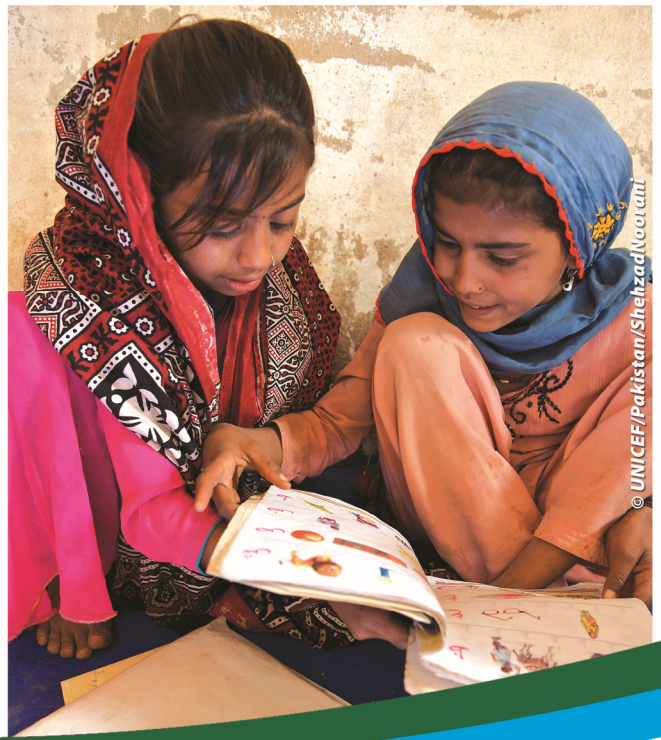

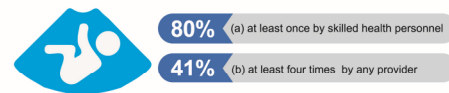

ADOLESCENT BIRTH RATE



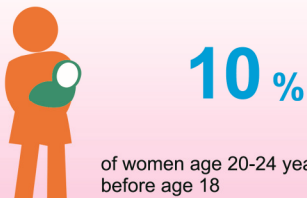
Age-specific fertility rate for women age 15-19 years

EARLY CHILDBEARING



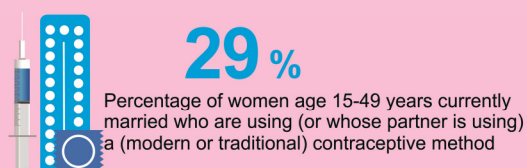
of women age 20-24 years who had at least one live birth before age 18

INSTITUTIONAL DELIVERIES



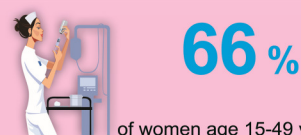
of women age 15-49 years with a live birth in the last 2 years whose most recent live birth was delivered in a health facility
