 - 54 Field Staff and 1 DP Staff were trained.




Monitoring of Data Collection


- A rigorous approach was used during the monitoring of data collection for quality results. Following steps were taken:
 - Dedicated Division-wise Field Monitors
 - Submission of *Field Monitoring Report* on daily basis and necessary actions are taken within two days.
 - Field Check Tables (FCTs)
 - Desk Monitors at BOS Head Office for the daily attendance of team and troubleshooting of day-to-day technical matters. Desk monitors also guide teams as per observations of FCTs.
 - Along with the technical monitoring, data collection teams are administratively monitored to maintain the discipline and punctuality in field.
 - Field monitoring of BOS and UNICEF MICS Core team.























