**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

**SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED  
ON 02.04.2026**

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 Shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops & 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report of the same period. The Week on Week (WoW) and Month on Month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As validation strategy, the SPI of Sindh has been crosschecked against PBS price data of four major cities (Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, and Larkana) of Sindh disseminated under National SPI by PBS for the same week ended on 02.04.2026 wherein a very minor variation has been observed, whereas the overall trend remained comparable and consistent. The SPI for Sindh calculated by SBOS on PBS's price data of 4 major cities of Sindh disseminated under National SPI as week ended on 02.04.2026 is provided hereunder for comparison:

**ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:**

SPI-Sindh for the current week as on 02.04.2026 increased by 0.46 percent compared with the previous week. An increase was registered in 17 commodities out of the basket of 50 essential items. The major increase was recorded in LPG Cylinder, 11kg (21.4%), followed by Milk, Fresh, Unboiled (3.3%), Salt Powder, Loose, Lahori (3.1%) and Tea Prepared, Average Hotel (2.8%). Other notable increases were observed in Curd (Dahi) (2.2%), and Eggs Hen, Farm (2.2%). Moderate increases were also seen in Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (1.7%), Energy Saver (14 watts) (1.7%), Mutton, Average Quality (1.5%), Cooking Oil, Tin, (1.5%) Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (1.2%), and Firewood Whole (1.2%). The lowest increases were recorded in Red

Chili Powder, Loose (0.3%) Pulse Moong, Washed (0.3%), and Cigarettes, K-2/Capstan, 20's (0.4%).

On the other hand, a decrease was observed in 26 commodities, with the major decrease recorded in Sandal (Ladies) (-6.4%), followed by Onions (-5.2%), Cooked Daal, Average Hotel (-4.2%), Tomatoes (-3.9%) and Sandal Bata (Gents) (-3.6%). Other decreases were noted in Wheat Flour, Bag Average Quality (-3.3%), Pulse Gram, Washed (-3.3%), and Long Cloth (-3.2%). Moderate declines were also observed in Potatoes (-2.9%), Garlic (-2.5%), and Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (-2.0%). The lowest decrease was recorded in Tea Lipton Yellow Lable (-0.2%) Vegetable Ghee (Loose) (-0.2%), Vegetable Ghee, Tin 2.5Kg (-0.4%), and Georgette (-0.6%).

The prices of 7 commodities remained unchanged, including Bread Plain, Mustard Oil, Electricity Charges, Gas Charges, Match Box, Petrol, and Hi Speed Diesel (HSP).

## PART-II (SPI REPORT)

### **CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (02.04.2026 OVER 26.03.2026)**

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the week ended on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026 indicates an overall increase of 0.46 percent compared to the previous week. The rise in the index was primarily driven by notable increases in Dairy (3.18%), Tea (1.53%) and Spices & Condiments (1.04%), indicating upward pressure across essential consumption groups.

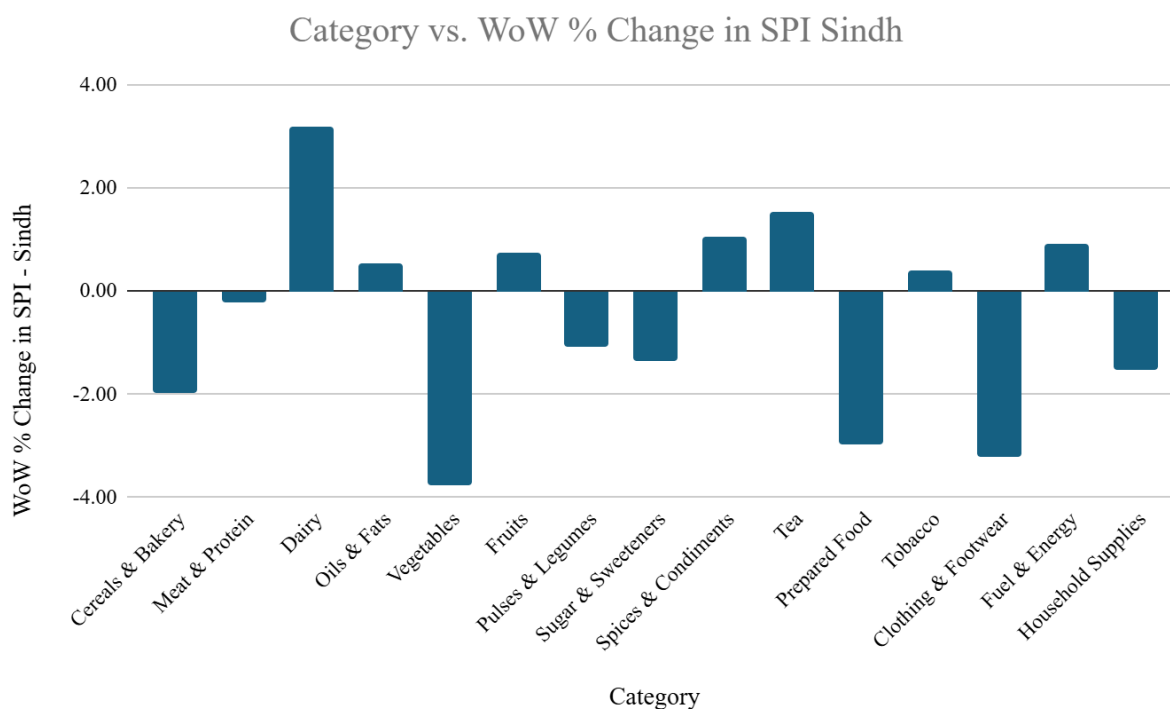
On the other hand, significant declines were observed in Vegetables (-3.75%), Clothing & Footwear (-3.21%), and Prepared Food (-2.97%), providing partial relief in selected food categories during the week.

Several categories showed moderate changes, including Fuel & Energy (+0.92%), Fruits (+0.73%) and Oil & Fats (+0.55) while no category remained stable during the period.

Overall, the weekly trend in SPI-Sindh reflects mixed price movements with a dominant food-driven inflationary pattern, where increases in perishable and essential items outweighed the declines observed in other categories. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.
