EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED
ON 09.04.2026**

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 Shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops & 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The Week on Week (WoW) and Month on Month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As validation strategy, the SPI of Sindh has been cross-checked against PBS price data of four major cities (Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, and Larkana) of Sindh disseminated under National SPI by PBS for the same week ended on 09.04.2026 wherein the overall trend remained comparable and consistent. The SPI for Sindh calculated by SBOS on PBS's price data of 4 major cities of Sindh disseminated under National SPI for the week ended on 09.04.2026 is provided hereunder for comparison:

ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:

SPI-Sindh for the current week as on 09.04.2026 increased by 2.17 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index also showed an overall increase of 4.38 percent, indicating a continued upward trend in prices of essential commodities. The WoW increase was registered in 29 commodities out of the basket of 50 essential items. The major increase was recorded in Hi-Speed Diesel (HSP) (54.7%), followed by Petrol, Super (17.9%), Tomatoes (12.2%), and Onions (5.5%), reflecting significant upward pressure in fuel and perishable food items. Other notable increases were observed in Washing Soap, 200–250g (5.0%),

Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (3.8%), and Cooked Daal, Average Hotel (3.8%). Moderate increases were also seen in Potatoes (3.0%), Mustard Oil, Average Quality (2.7%), Tea Prepared, Average Hotel (2.7%), and Vegetable Ghee, Tin (2.5%). The lowest increases were recorded in Cooking Oil, Tin (0.7%), Sugar, Refined (0.7%), Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (0.5%), and Energy Saver (14 watts) (0.4%).

On the other hand, a decrease was observed in 13 commodities, with the major decrease recorded in Garlic (-6.6%), followed by Bananas (-5.8%), and Salt Powder, Loose, Lahori (-3.0%). Other decreases were noted in Sandal Bata (Gents) (-2.0%) and Shirting (-1.8%). Moderate declines were also observed in Wheat Flour, Bag Average Quality (-1.2%), Firewood Whole (-0.7%), and Curd (Dahi) (-0.4%). The lowest decrease was recorded in Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (-0.4%), Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (-0.3%), and Mutton, Average Quality (-0.1%).

The prices of 8 commodities remained unchanged, including Bread Plain (Medium Size), Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live, Tea, Lipton Yellow Label (Packet), Cooked Beef, Average Hotel, Cigarettes, K-2/Capstan, 20's, Electricity Charges, Gas Charges, and Match Box, Regular.

Overall, the weekly trend reflects broad-based increases led by fuel and vegetable prices, while limited declines in selected commodities provided partial relief. The concurrent rise in both WoW and MoM indicators suggests sustained inflationary pressure across essential consumption items in Sindh.

PART-II (SPI REPORT)

CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (09.04.2026 OVER 02.04.2026)

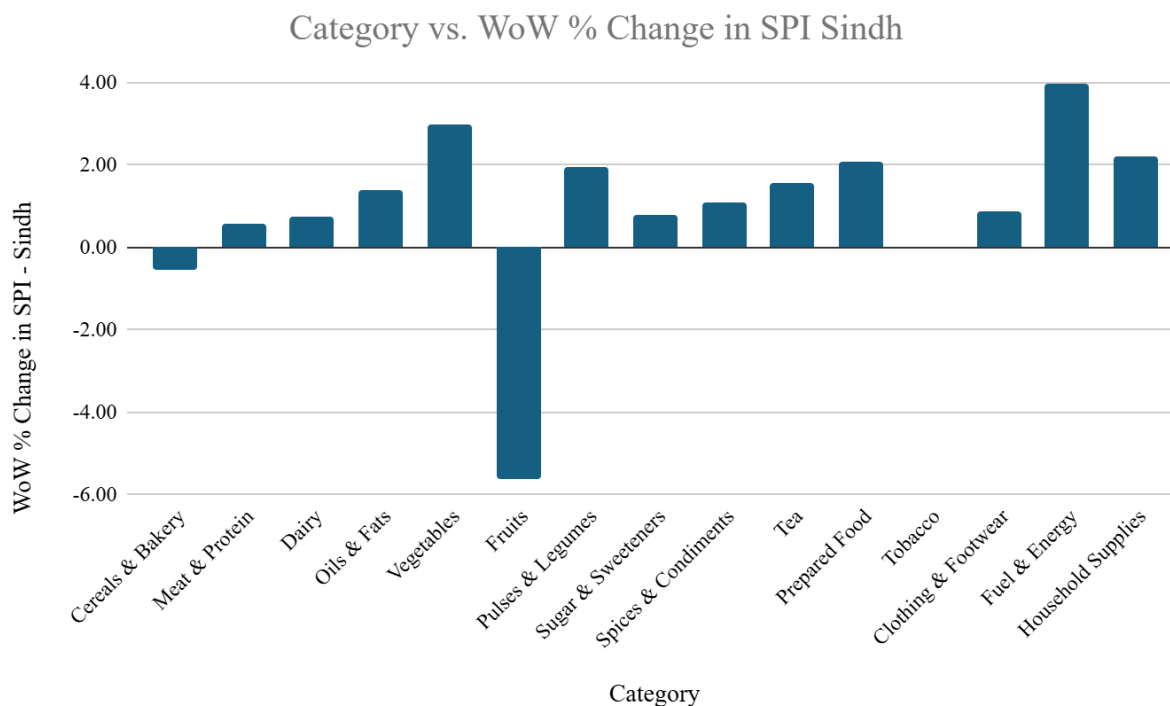
The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the week ended on 9th April 2026 indicates an overall increase of 2.17 percent compared to the previous week. The rise in the index was primarily driven by notable increases in Fuel & Energy (3.95%), Vegetables (2.97%) and Household Supplies (2.22%), indicating strong upward pressure across essential consumption groups.

On the other hand, a significant decline was observed in Fruits (-5.63%), while a slight decrease was recorded in Cereals & Bakery (-0.55%), providing partial relief in selected food categories during the week.

Several categories showed moderate increases, including Prepared Food (2.09%), Pulses & Legumes (1.96%), Tea (1.56%), and Oils & Fats (1.38%). Additional upward movements were observed in Spices & Condiments (1.10%), Clothing & Footwear (0.87%), Dairy (0.76%), and Sugar & Sweeteners (0.77%). A relatively smaller increase was recorded in Meat & Protein (0.56%). Meanwhile, Tobacco (0.00%) remained stable during the week with no change in prices. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.

CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (09.04.2026 OVER 12.03.2026)

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the period ending on 9th April 2026 indicates an overall increase of 4.38 percent compared to 12th March 2026. The rise in the index was primarily driven by notable increases in Fuel & Energy (7.46%), Vegetables (7.07%), and Meat & Protein (6.84%), reflecting strong upward pressure across essential consumption groups.

Further significant increases were observed in Spices & Condiments (5.77%), Dairy (3.71%), Tea (3.48%), and Prepared Food (3.10%), indicating broad-based price escalation in both food and non-food categories. Moderate increases were also recorded in Oils & Fats (2.80%) and Household Supplies (2.53%), while a relatively smaller increase was observed in Tobacco (1.72%).

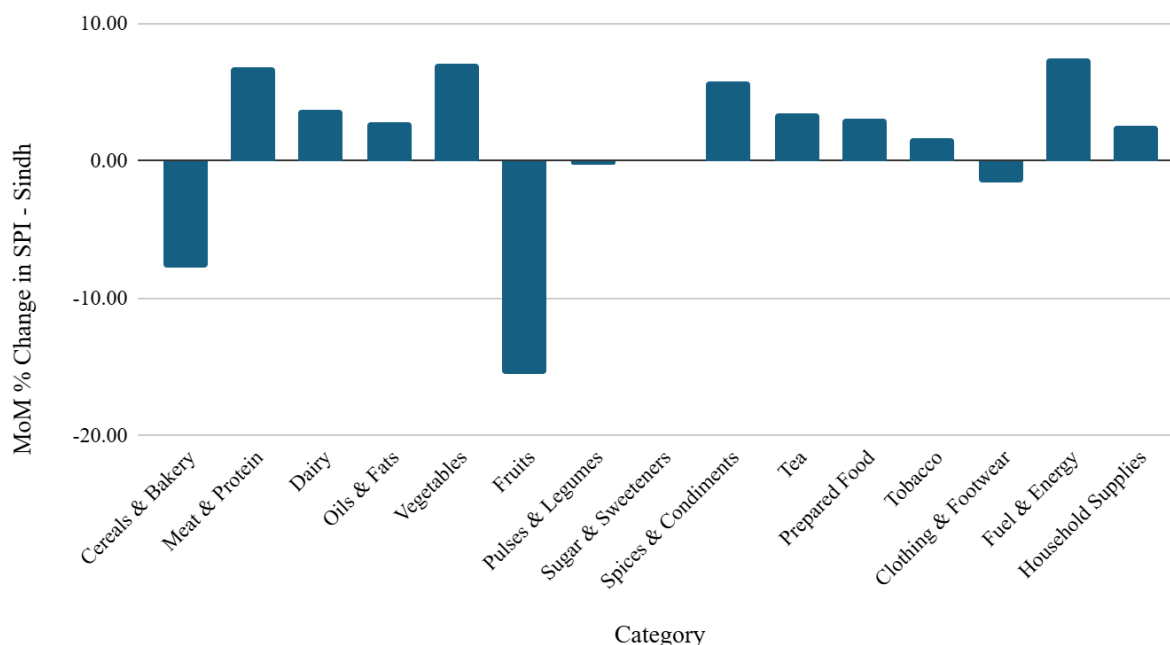
On the other hand, a sharp decline was observed in Fruits (-15.55%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (-7.75%), indicating significant relief in selected food categories. A slight decrease was also recorded in Clothing & Footwear (-1.52%) and Pulses & Legumes (-0.27%).

Meanwhile, Sugar & Sweeteners (0.00%) remained stable during the period with no change in prices. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.
