**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

**SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED  
ON 16.04.2026**

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 Shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops & 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The Week on Week (WoW) and Month on Month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As validation strategy, the SPI of Sindh has been cross-checked against PBS price data of four major cities (Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, and Larkana) of Sindh disseminated under National SPI by PBS for the same week ended on 16.04.2026 wherein trend remained comparable and consistent. The SPI for Sindh calculated by SBOS on PBS's price data of 4 major cities of Sindh disseminated under National SPI for the week ended on 16.04.2026 is provided hereunder for comparison:

**ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:**

SPI-Sindh for the current week as on 16.04.2026 decreased by -0.21 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index showed an overall increase of 3.64 percent, indicating a continued upward trend in prices of essential commodities. During the current a decrease was observed in 15 commodities, with the major decrease recorded in Hi Speed Diesel (HSP) (-25.8%), followed by Garlic (-11.8%), and Onions (-6.9%). Other decreases were noted in LPG Cylinder, 11kg (-3.9%) and Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (-3.2%). Moderate declines were also observed in Petrol, Super (-3.1%), Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (-2.2%), and Mustard Oil,

Average Quality (-1.7%). The lowest decrease was recorded in Red Chili Powder, Loose (-0.7%), and Lawn (-0.4%).

On the other hand, an increase was registered in 25 commodities out of the basket of 50 essential items. The major increase was recorded in Tomatoes (36.4%), followed by Eggs Hen, Farm (3.4%), Firewood Whole (3.0%), and Energy Saver (14 watts) (3.0%). Other notable increases were observed in Cooked Beef, Average Hotel (2.7%), Bread Plain, Medium Size (2.5%), and Cooking Oil, Tin (2.4%). Moderate increases were also seen in Curd (Dahi) (2.2%), Sandal Bata (Gents) (2.2%), Soap, Lifebuoy (1.7%), and Mutton, Average Quality (1.3%). The lowest increases were recorded in Sandal Bata (Ladies) (0.3%), Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (0.2%), Vegetable Ghee (Loose) (0.2%), and Pulse Mash, Washed (0.2%).

The prices of 10 commodities remained unchanged, including Bananas, Potatoes, Sugar, Refined Salt Powder Loose, Lahori, Tea Lipton Yellow Label Packet, Tea Prepared, Average Hotel, Cigarette K2/Capstan 20s packet, Electricity Charges, Upto 50 Units, Gas Charges, Upto 3.3719 MMBTU, Match Box, Regular.

The weekly trend reflects decrease in fuel and in some selected commodities prices which provided partial relief. Whereas MoM indicators suggests sustained inflationary pressure across essential consumption items in Sindh.

## **PART-II (SPI REPORT)**

### **CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (16.04.2026 OVER 09.04.2026)**

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the week ended on 16th April 2026 indicates an overall decrease of -0.21 percent compared to the previous week. The decline in the index was primarily driven by notable decrease in Fuel & Energy (-1.04%), Spices & Condiments (-0.73%), and Cereals & Bakery (-0.19%), providing partial relief in selected food categories during the week.

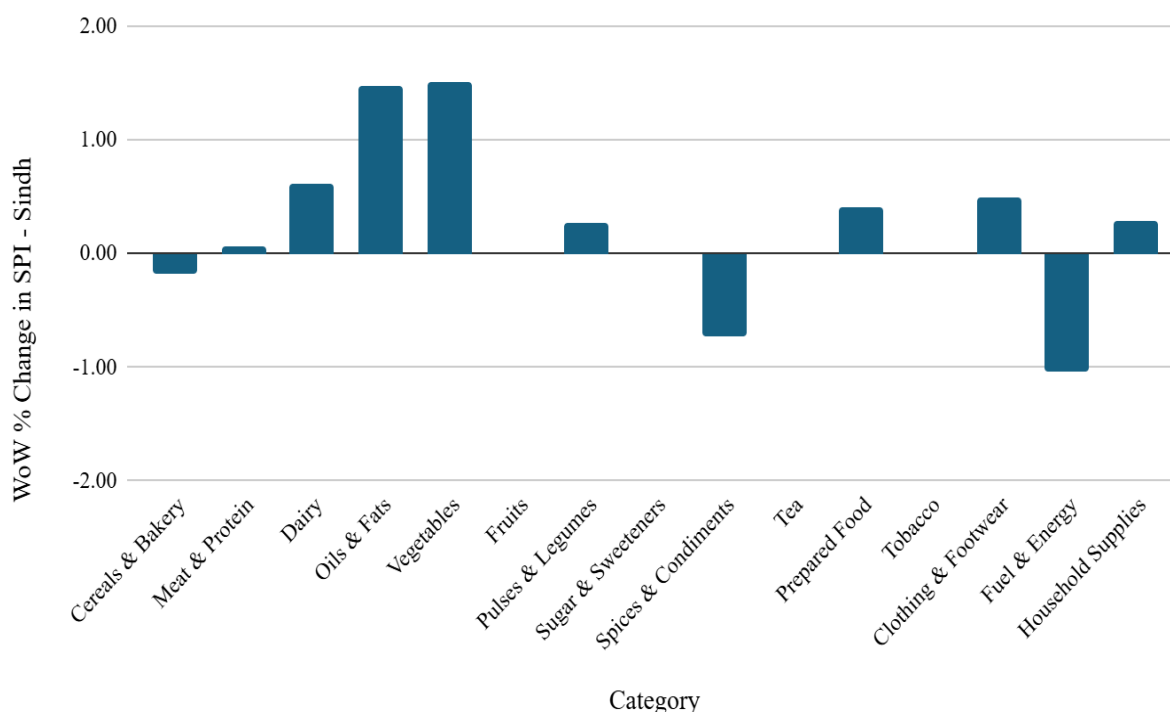
On the other hand, a significant increase was observed in Vegetables (1.51%), and Oils & Fats (1.47%), indicating upward pressure across essential consumption groups.

Several categories showed moderate increases, including Dairy (0.62%), Clothing & Footwear (0.50%), Prepared Food (0.41%), and Household Supplies (0.29%). Additional upward movements were observed in Pulses & Legumes (0.27%). A relatively smaller increase was recorded in Meat & Protein (0.06%). Meanwhile, Fruits, Sugar & Sweeteners and Tea remained stable during the week with no change in prices. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.

## CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (16.04.2026 OVER 19.03.2026)

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the period ending on 16th April 2026 indicates an overall increase of 3.64 percent compared to 19th March 2026. The rise in the index was primarily driven by notable increases in Fuel & Energy (6.34%), Vegetables (4.53%), Oils & Fats (4.19%), and Dairy (4.19%), reflecting strong upward pressure across essential consumption groups.

Further significant increases were observed in Household Supplies (3.90%), Spices & Condiments (3.41%), Meat & Protein (3.00%), and Tea (2.66%), indicating broad-based price escalation in both food and non-food categories. Moderate increases were also recorded in Prepared Food (2.37%), while a relatively smaller increase was observed in Tobacco (0.43%).

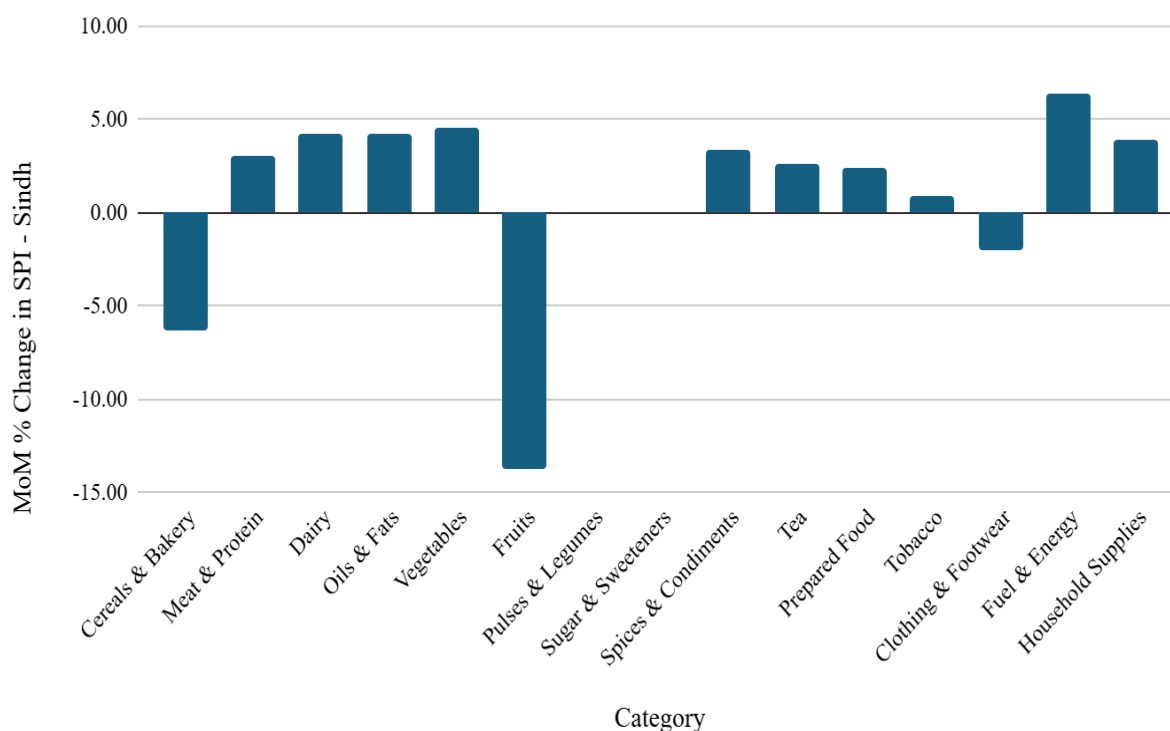
On the other hand, a sharp decline was observed in Fruits (-13.73%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (-6.32%), indicating significant relief in selected food categories. A slight decrease was also recorded in Clothing & Footwear (-1.52%).

Meanwhile, Pulses & Legumes (0.00%) and Sugar & Sweeteners remained stable during the period with no change in prices. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.
