EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED
ON 23.04.2026**

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 Shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops & 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The Week on Week (WoW) and Month on Month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As validation strategy, the SPI of Sindh has been cross-checked against PBS price data of four major cities (Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur, and Larkana) of Sindh disseminated under National SPI by PBS for the same week ended on 23.04.2026 wherein trend remained comparable and consistent. The SPI for Sindh calculated by SBOS on PBS's price data of 4 major cities of Sindh disseminated under National SPI for the week ended on 23.04.2026 is provided hereunder for comparison:

ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:

SPI-Sindh for the current week as on 23.04.2026 decreased by -0.44 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index showed an overall increase of 1.97 percent, indicating a mixed trend with short-term relief but continued upward pressure over the longer period.

During the current week, a decrease was observed in 21 commodities, with the major decrease recorded in Tomatoes (-16.0%), followed by Hi-Speed Diesel (HSP) (-8.2%), and LPG Cylinder, 11kg (-6.4%). Other decreases were noted in Onions (-3.7%) and Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (-2.9%). Moderate declines were also observed in Potatoes (-2.9%), Red Chili Powder, Loose (-

2.7%), and Energy Saver (14 watts) (-2.1%), while smaller decreases were recorded in Pulse Masoor, washed (-1.9%), Washing Soap, 200–250g (-1.9%), and Cooked Beef, Average Hotel (-1.8%). The lowest decrease was recorded in Petrol, Super (-0.3%) and Lawn (-0.2%).

On the other hand, an increase was registered in 17 commodities out of the basket of 50 essential items. The major increase was recorded in Eggs Hen, Farm (3.3%), followed by Garlic (2.4%), Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (2.0%), and Sandal Bata (Gents) (1.9%). Other notable increases were observed in Bananas (1.5%), Pulse Gram, Washed (1.5%), and Shirting (1.4%). Moderate increases were also seen in Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (1.1%), Sandal Bata (Ladies) (1.1%), and Georgette (1.0%), while smaller increases were recorded in Vegetable Ghee, Tin (0.6%) and Cigarettes, K-2/Capstan, 20's (0.4%).

The prices of 12 commodities remained unchanged, including Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh), Mustard Oil, Average Quality, Cooking Oil, Tin, Sugar, Refined, Salt Powder, Loose, Lahori, Tea Lipton Yellow Label Packet, Cooked Daal, Average Hotel, Tea Prepared, Average Hotel, Electricity Charges, Gas Charges, Match Box, Regular, and Soap, Lifebuoy.

The weekly trend reflects a decline in fuel and key perishable commodity prices, which provided partial relief during the week. However, the MoM indicators suggest sustained inflationary pressure across essential consumption items in Sindh.

PART-II (SPI REPORT)

CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (23.04.2026 OVER 16.04.2026)

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the week ended on 23rd April 2026 indicates an overall decrease of -0.43 percent compared to the previous week. The decline in the index was primarily driven by notable decreases in Vegetables (-5.15%), Spices & Condiments (-1.83%), and Household Supplies (-1.01%), reflecting a downward movement in key consumption categories during the week.

On the other hand, a noticeable increase was observed in Fruits (1.49%), followed by Clothing & Footwear (0.59%) and Tobacco (0.42%), indicating localized upward pressure in selected non-food and perishable segments.

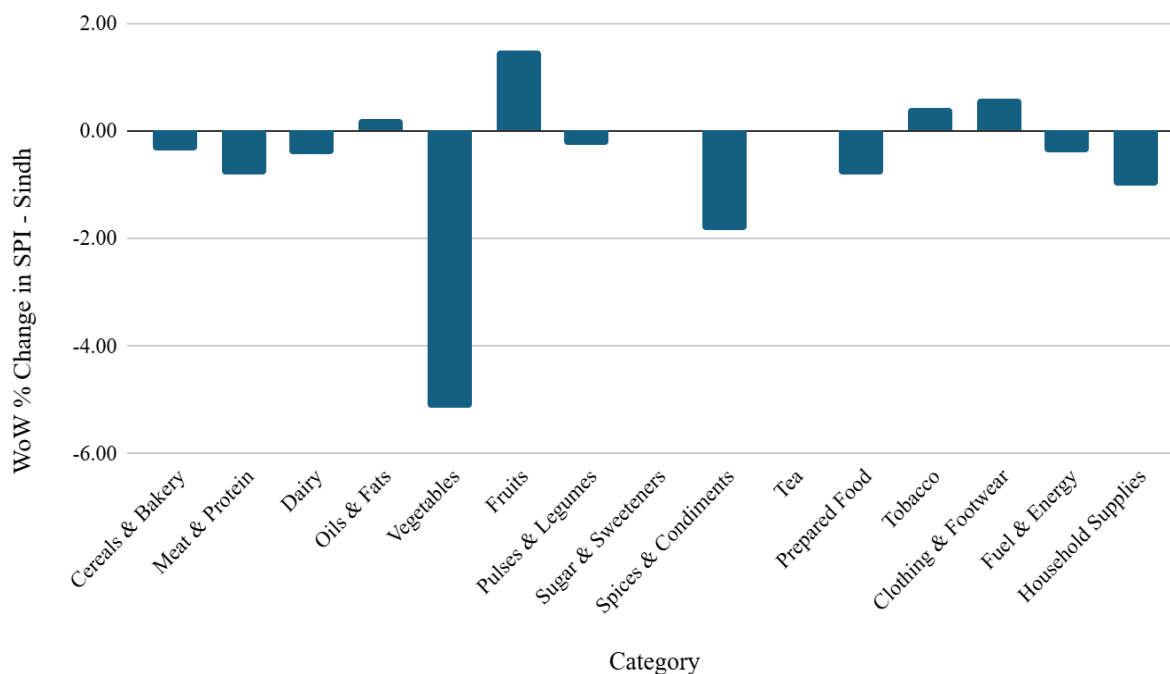
Several categories showed moderate changes, including Meat & Protein (-0.80%), Prepared Food (-0.82%), Dairy (-0.44%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.41%), while Cereals & Bakery (-0.37%) and Pulses & Legumes (-0.27%) recorded relatively smaller decreases during the week.

Meanwhile, Sugar & Sweeteners and Tea remained stable with no change (0.00%) during the period. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference

CATEGORY-WISE DIVISION LEVEL ANALYSIS (WoW)

The division-wise analysis of SPI-Sindh reveals mixed price movements across regions during the week ended on 23rd April 2026, with no uniform trend observed across all categories and divisions.

A significant decline was observed in Vegetables across all divisions, with decreases ranging from -0.6 percent in Mirpurkhas to -9.2 percent in Shaheed Benazirabad, indicating a broad-based reduction in vegetable prices and contributing substantially to the overall downward movement in the index.

On the other hand, Fruits exhibited strong upward movement in several divisions, particularly in Mirpurkhas (17.6%), Larkana (5.1%), and Sukkur (4.3%), while Karachi showed a sharp decline (-7.1%), reflecting considerable regional volatility in this category.

Prepared Food showed mixed trends, with notable increases in Shaheed Benazirabad (2.2%), while significant decreases were recorded in Larkana (-3.0%), Karachi (-1.3%), and Hyderabad (-1.2%), indicating uneven price movements across regions.

A consistent downward trend was observed in Fuel & Energy across all divisions, with declines ranging from -0.9 percent to -2.9 percent, reflecting easing pressure on energy-related commodities during the week.

Spices & Condiments also recorded declines in most divisions, particularly in Larkana (-2.0%) and Hyderabad (-1.1%), while remaining relatively stable in Sukkur and Mirpurkhas.

Moderate and mixed movements were observed in categories such as Oils & Fats and Pulses & Legumes, with increases in some divisions (e.g., Hyderabad and Larkana) and decreases in others, indicating localized variations in consumption patterns and supply conditions.

Meanwhile, categories such as Sugar & Sweeteners and Tea remained largely stable across divisions, with minimal or no changes recorded in most regions.

Overall, the division-wise SPI trend highlights a vegetable-driven decline and energy price easing, accompanied by significant regional variation in fruits and prepared food categories, reflecting the dynamic nature of price movements across Sindh.

CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (23.04.2026 OVER 26.03.2026)

The category-wise analysis of the Sensitive Price Index (SPI-Sindh) for the period ending on 23rd April 2026 indicates an overall increase of 1.97 percent compared to 26th March 2026. The rise in the index was primarily driven by notable increases in Dairy (4.17%), Oils & Fats (3.68%), Fuel & Energy (3.38%), and Tea (3.10%), reflecting upward pressure across key consumption groups.

Further increases were observed in Pulses & Legumes (1.11%) and Tobacco (0.85%), indicating moderate upward movement in selected categories.

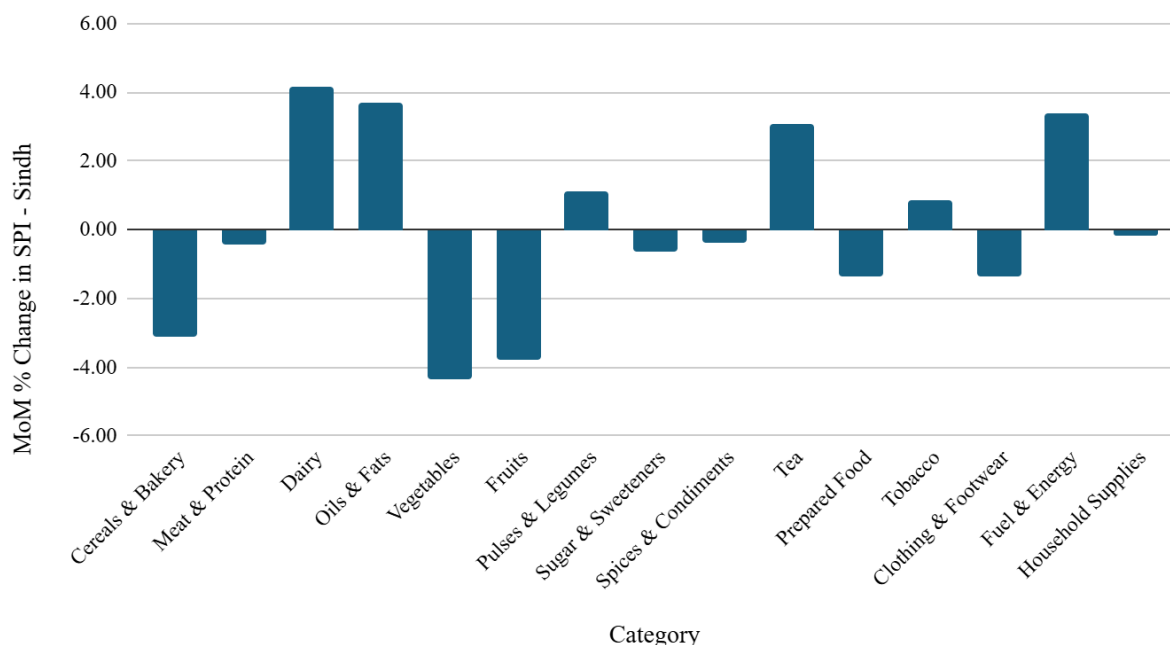
On the other hand, a significant decline was observed in Vegetables (-4.37%), followed by Fruits (-3.77%) and Cereals & Bakery (-3.13%), providing relief in major food groups during the period. Additional decreases were recorded in Prepared Food (-1.36%) and Clothing & Footwear (-1.38%), while Meat & Protein (-0.42%), Spices & Condiments (-0.37%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.63%), and Household Supplies (-0.15%) showed relatively smaller declines.

No category remained completely stable during the period, indicating overall dynamic price movements across all major consumption groups. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A for reference.
