WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

- SPI-Sindh increased by 0.30% WoW also marginally increased by 0.78% MoM.
- Vegetables recorded the highest category increase (+4.32%), while Fruits registered the largest decline (-0.97%).
- Onions (+13.3%) and Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (+6.8%) recorded the largest increases, while Long Cloth registered the decline (-1.6%), followed by Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (-1.5%).
- SPI-Sindh calculated by SBOS using PBS price data for four major cities also increased by 0.45%.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 06.08.2026

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops and 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The week-on-week (WoW) and month-on-month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As a validation strategy, SPI-Sindh was cross-checked against the PBS price data for four major cities of Sindh—Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Larkana disseminated under the National SPI for the week ended on 06.08.2026. The direction of movement remained comparable and consistent. The SPI calculated by SBOS using the PBS price data for these four cities is presented below for comparison.

ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:

SPI-Sindh for the current week ended on 06.08.2026 increased by 0.30 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index recorded an increase of 0.78 percent. This indicates a marginal increase in the prices of essential commodities during the week and MoM basis.

During the current week, an increase was observed in 19 commodities. The highest increase was recorded in Onions (+13.3%), followed by Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (+6.8%), Potatoes (+2.0%), Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (+2.0%), and Lawn (+1.9%). Other notable increases were observed in Garlic (+1.7%), Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (+1.6%), Eggs Hen, Farm (+1.3%), Mustard Oil, Average Quality (+1.2%), Cooking Oil, Tin (+1.0%), Beef With Bone, Average quality

(+0.7%), and Vegetable Ghee, Tin (+0.6%). Moderate increases were also recorded in Georgette (+0.6%), Firewood Whole (+0.6%), Milk, Fresh, Unboiled (+0.4%), Tomatoes (+0.4%), Energy Saver (14 watts) (+0.4%), Mutton, Average Quality (+0.3%) and Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (+0.3%).

On the other hand, a decrease was recorded in 19 commodities. The largest decrease was observed in Long Cloth (-1.6%), followed by Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (-1.5%), Hi Speed Diesel (HSP) (-1.5%), Red Chilli Powder, Loose (-1.0%), Pulse Mash, Washed (-0.9%), Washing Soap, 200-250 gm (-0.9%), and Bread Plain, Medium Size (-0.8%). Other decreases were recorded in Vegetable Ghee (Loose) (-0.8%), Bananas (-0.7%), Sugar, Refined (-0.7%), LPG Cylinder, 11kg (-0.7%), Cooked Daal, Average Hotel (-0.6%), Petrol, Super (-0.6%), Pulse Gram, Washed (-0.4%), Curd (Dahi) (-0.3%), Pulse Moong, Washed (-0.3%), Wheat Flour, Bag Average Quality (-0.2%), Sandal Bata (Ladies) (-0.2%), and Sandal Bata (Gents) (-0.1%).

The prices of 12 commodities remained unchanged, including Pulse Masoor(Washed), Gur(Average Quality), Salt Powder(Loose, Lahori), Tea (Lipton Yellow Label), Cooked Beef(Average Hotel), Tea Prepared (Average Hotel), Cigarettes (K-2/Capstan,20's), Shirting, Electricity Charges (upto 50 Units), Gas Charges (upto 3.3719 MMBTU), Match Box (Regular), Soap(Lifebuoy).

The weekly trend reflects slightly rising price pressure from food and non-energy related commodities, particularly Onions, Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live, Potatoes, and Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents). These increases outweighed decreases in Long Cloth, Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh), Hi Speed Diesel (HSP), Red Chilli Powder, Loose, and selected prepared food and pulse items. Similarly, the marginal MoM increase of 0.78 percent indicates that the overall price level remained broadly higher, though slightly above that recorded during the corresponding week of the previous month.

CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (06.08.2026 OVER 30.07.2026)

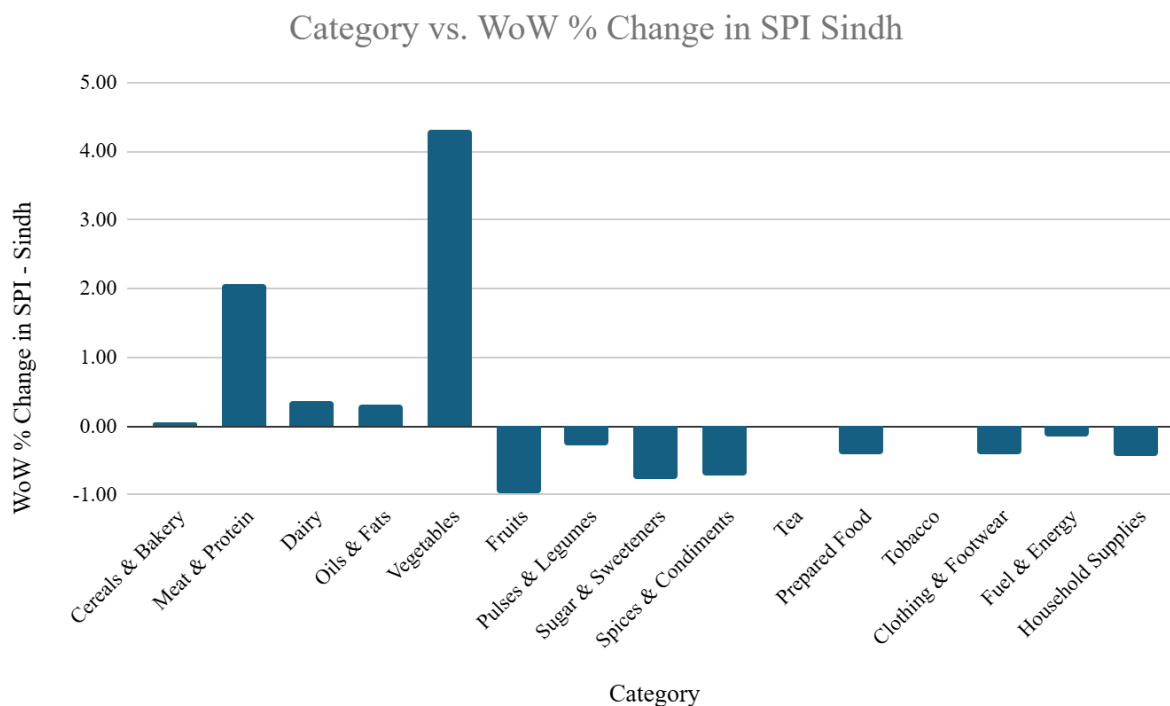
The category-wise analysis of SPI-Sindh for the week ended 06.08.2026 indicates an overall increase of 0.30 percent over the previous week. The increase was led by Vegetables (4.32%), followed by Meat & Protein (2.08%), Dairy (-0.36%), Oils & Fats (0.3%), and Cereals & Bakery (-0.05%).

decreases were recorded in Fruits (-0.97%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.77%), Spices & Condiments (-0.72%), Household Supplies (-0.43%), Clothing & Footwear (-0.41%), Prepared Food (-0.4%), Pulses & Legumes (-0.27%) and Fuel & Energy (-0.15%).

Tea & Tobacco remained unchanged (0.00%) during the week. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.

CATEGORY-WISE DIVISION LEVEL ANALYSIS (WoW)

The division-wise analysis indicates considerable regional variation in weekly price movements. At the provincial (Sindh) level, the largest increases were recorded in Vegetables (+4.4%) and Meat & Protein (+2.3%), followed by Clothing & Footwear (+0.3%) and Oils & Fats (+0.1%). Cereals & Bakery, Dairy, Tea, and Tobacco remained unchanged at 0.0%. The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-1.0%), followed by Fuel & Energy (-0.5%), Spices & Condiments (-0.5%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.4%), Prepared Food (-0.4%), Pulses & Legumes (-0.3%), and Household Supplies (-0.2%).

Karachi recorded the highest increase in Vegetables (+4.9%), followed by Meat & Protein (+3.5%) and Clothing & Footwear (+1.7%). Smaller increases were observed in Sugar & Sweeteners (+0.6%), Pulses & Legumes (+0.4%), Oils & Fats (+0.3%), and Dairy (+0.1%). Fuel & Energy remained unchanged (0.0%). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-2.0%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (-1.3%), Spices & Condiments (-1.1%), Household Supplies (-0.9%), Prepared Food (-0.7%), Tea (-0.7%), and Tobacco (-0.6%).

Hyderabad registered increases in Vegetables (+4.8%), Meat & Protein (+1.3%), Dairy (+0.9%), Sugar & Sweeteners (+0.6%), and Oils & Fats (+0.5%). Tea, Prepared Food, and Household Supplies remained unchanged (0.0%). The sharpest decline was recorded in Fruits (-1.6%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (-0.9%), Fuel & Energy (-0.8%), Spices & Condiments (-0.4%), Tobacco (-0.2%), Clothing & Footwear (-0.2%), and Pulses & Legumes (-0.1%).

Sukkur recorded increases in Meat & Protein (+3.0%), Vegetables (+1.9%), Cereals & Bakery (+1.7%), Oils & Fats (+0.8%), Spices & Condiments (+0.7%), Household Supplies (+0.7%), Clothing & Footwear (+0.6%), and Dairy (+0.5%). Tea, Prepared Food, and Tobacco remained unchanged (0.0%). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-10.4%), followed by Fuel & Energy (-0.9%), Pulses & Legumes (-0.8%), and Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.4%).

Larkana recorded increases in Vegetables (+2.8%), Meat & Protein (+1.0%), Oils & Fats (+0.9%), Cereals & Bakery (+0.8%), and Fuel & Energy (+0.1%). Tea, Prepared Food, Tobacco, and Household Supplies remained unchanged (0.0%). The sharpest decline was observed in Sugar &

Sweeteners (-2.3%), followed by Pulses & Legumes (-1.8%), Spices & Condiments (-1.2%), Dairy (-1.0%), Fruits (-0.8%), and Clothing & Footwear (-0.1%).

Mirpurkhas recorded a substantial increase in Fruits (+14.5%), followed by Meat & Protein (+5.9%) and Vegetables (+4.3%). Fuel & Energy declined by -0.2%, while Cereals & Bakery, Dairy, Oils & Fats, Pulses & Legumes, Sugar & Sweeteners, Spices & Condiments, Tea, Prepared Food, Tobacco, Clothing & Footwear, and Household Supplies remained unchanged (0.0%).

Shaheed Benazirabad recorded increases in Vegetables (+8.1%), Tobacco (+2.8%), Prepared Food (+1.4%), Meat & Protein (+1.0%), Household Supplies (+0.9%), Spices & Condiments (+0.7%), Cereals & Bakery (+0.5%), Oils & Fats (+0.3%), and Dairy (+0.2%). Sugar & Sweeteners and Clothing & Footwear remained unchanged (0.0%). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-4.0%), followed by Tea (-1.2%), Fuel & Energy (-0.6%), and Pulses & Legumes (-0.2%).

Overall, weekly price movements were primarily influenced by substantial increases in Vegetables and Meat & Protein. Vegetable prices increased across all six divisions, with the highest increases recorded in Shaheed Benazirabad, Karachi, and Hyderabad. Meat & Protein also increased across all six divisions, led by Mirpurkhas, Karachi, and Sukkur. Fruits showed mixed regional movements, with a sharp increase in Mirpurkhas offset by substantial declines in Sukkur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Karachi, and Hyderabad. Fuel & Energy declined in most divisions except Larkana (+0.1%) and Karachi (0.0%). Pulses & Legumes showed mixed regional movements, with an increase in Karachi (+0.4%), static prices in Mirpurkhas (0.0%), and declines across Hyderabad, Sukkur, Larkana, and Shaheed Benazirabad. In contrast, the provincial declines in Spices & Condiments, Sugar & Sweeteners, Prepared Food, and Household Supplies reflected varying regional movements across the divisions.

Category-level values represent the **unweighted arithmetic average** of commodity-level changes within each respective category.

For each division, the representative price of every commodity is calculated as the geometric mean of its district-level prices. Base prices and commodity weights are then applied to obtain weighted price relatives for the current and previous weeks.

Commodity-level week-on-week percentage changes are calculated from the current- and previous-week weighted price relatives.

The Sindh column is calculated independently using the geometric mean of prices across all 30 districts for each commodity, followed by the same weighting, week-on-week change and category-aggregation procedure. It is not calculated from the six divisional values.

CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (06.08.2026 OVER 09.07.2026)

The category-wise MoM analysis for the period ending 06.08.2026 indicates a marginal overall increase of 0.78 percent compared with 09.07.2026. The increase was led by Vegetables (7.97%), followed by Meat & Protein (3.35%). Tobacco (1.25%), Dairy (1.05%), Cereals & Bakery (0.92%), Oils & Fats (0.71%), Pulses & Legumes (0.55%), Household Supplies (0.43%), and Fuel & Energy (0.10%) also increased during the period.

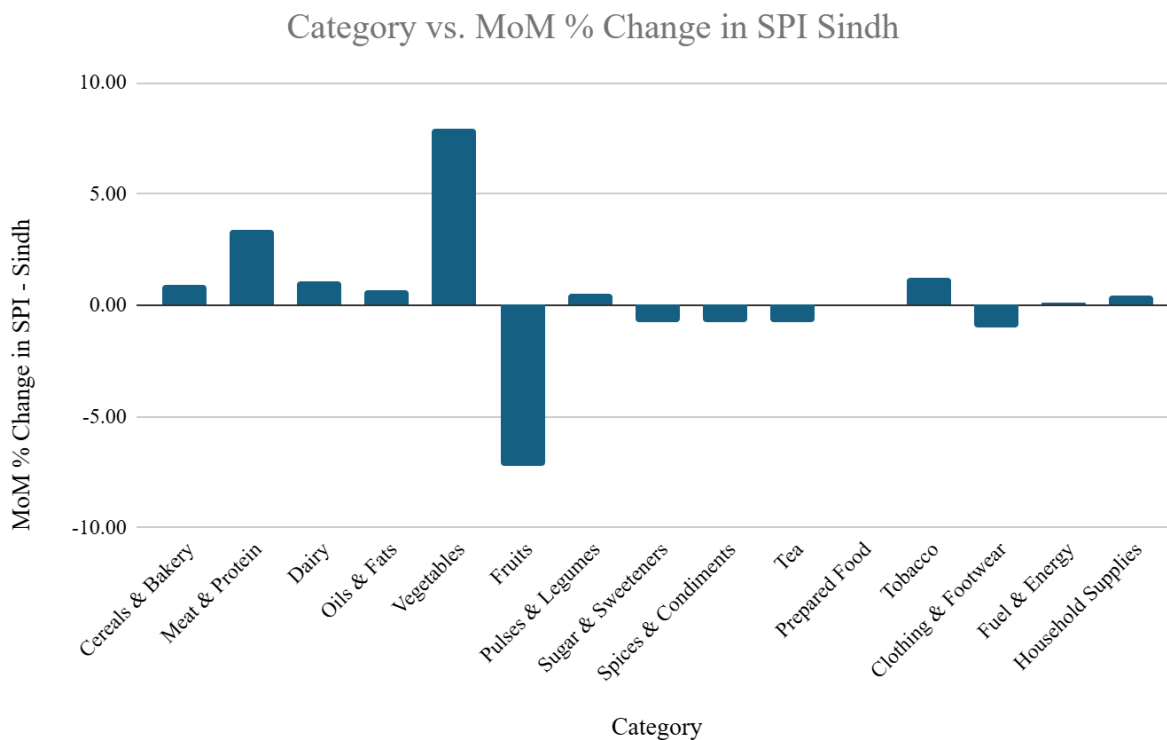
These increases were largely offset by decreases in Fruits (-7.24%), Clothing & Footwear (-1.0%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.77%), Tea (-0.76%), and Spices & Condiments (-0.72%).

Tea remained unchanged (0.00%) during the period. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.
