WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

- SPI-Sindh increased by 0.37% WoW and marginally increased by 0.21% MoM.
- Vegetables recorded the highest category increase (+7.79%), while Pulses & Legumes registered the largest decline (-1.10%).
- Onions (+18.6%) and Potatoes (+6.0%) recorded the largest increases, while Petrol, Super registered the largest decline (-2.4%), followed by Garlic (-2.3%).
- SPI-Sindh calculated by SBOS using PBS price data for four major cities also increased by 0.35%.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 13.08.2026

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops and 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The week-on-week (WoW) and month-on-month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As a validation strategy, SPI-Sindh was cross-checked against the PBS price data for four major cities of Sindh—Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Larkana disseminated under the National SPI for the week ended on 13.08.2026. The direction of movement remained comparable and consistent. The SPI calculated by SBOS using the PBS price data for these four cities is presented below for comparison.

ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:

SPI-Sindh for the current week ended on 13.08.2026 increased by 0.37 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index recorded an increase of 0.21 percent. This indicates a marginal increase in the prices of essential commodities during the week and on MoM basis.

During the current week, an increase was observed in 23 commodities. The highest increase was recorded in Onions (+18.6%), followed by Potatoes (+6.0%), Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (+5.1%), Tomatoes (+2.7%), and Eggs Hen, Farm (+2.5%). Other notable increases were observed in Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (+1.0%), Washing Soap, 200-250 gm (+1.0%), Wheat Flour, Bag Average Quality (+0.9%), Bread Plain, Medium Size (+0.8%), and Soap, Lifebuoy (+0.8%).

Moderate increases were also recorded in Shirting (+0.7%), Vegetable Ghee (Loose) (+0.6%), Cooked Daal, Average Hotel (+0.6%), Milk, Fresh, Unboiled (+0.4%), Curd (Dahi) (+0.4%), Mustard Oil, Average Quality (+0.4%), Energy Saver (14 watts) (+0.4%), and LPG Cylinder, 11kg (+0.4%). Marginal increases were also observed in Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (+0.3%), Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (+0.2%), Mutton, Average Quality (+0.1%), Sandal Bata (Gents) (+0.1%), and Firewood Whole (+0.1%).

On the other hand, a decrease was recorded in 16 commodities. The largest decrease was observed in Petrol, Super (-2.4%), followed by Garlic (-2.3%), Pulse Moong, Washed (-1.9%), Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (-1.5%), and Gur, Average Quality (-0.5%). Other decreases were recorded in Pulse Masoor, Washed (-0.4%), Pulse Gram, Washed (-0.4%), Cigarettes, K-2/Capstan, 20's (-0.4%), Beef With Bone, Average quality (-0.3%), Cooking Oil, Tin (-0.3%), Red Chilli Powder, Loose (-0.3%), and Hi-Speed Diesel (HSD) (-0.3%). Marginal decreases were also recorded in Vegetable Ghee, Tin (-0.2%), Pulse Mash, Washed (-0.2%), Lawn (-0.2%), and Sandal Bata (Ladies) (-0.1%).

The prices of 11 commodities remained unchanged, including Bananas, Sugar (Refined), Salt Powder (Loose, Lahori), Tea (Lipton Yellow Label), Cooked Beef (Average Hotel), Tea Prepared (Average Hotel), Long Cloth, Georgette, Electricity Charges (up to 50 Units), Gas Charges (up to 3.3719 MMBTU), and Match Box (Regular).

The weekly trend reflects slightly rising price pressure from food-related commodities, particularly Onions, Potatoes, Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live, and Tomatoes. These increases outweighed decreases in Petrol, Super, Garlic, Pulse Moong, Washed, and Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh), and selected pulse and fuel items. Similarly, the marginal MoM increase of 0.21 percent indicates that the overall price level remained broadly stable, though slightly above that recorded during the corresponding week of the previous month.

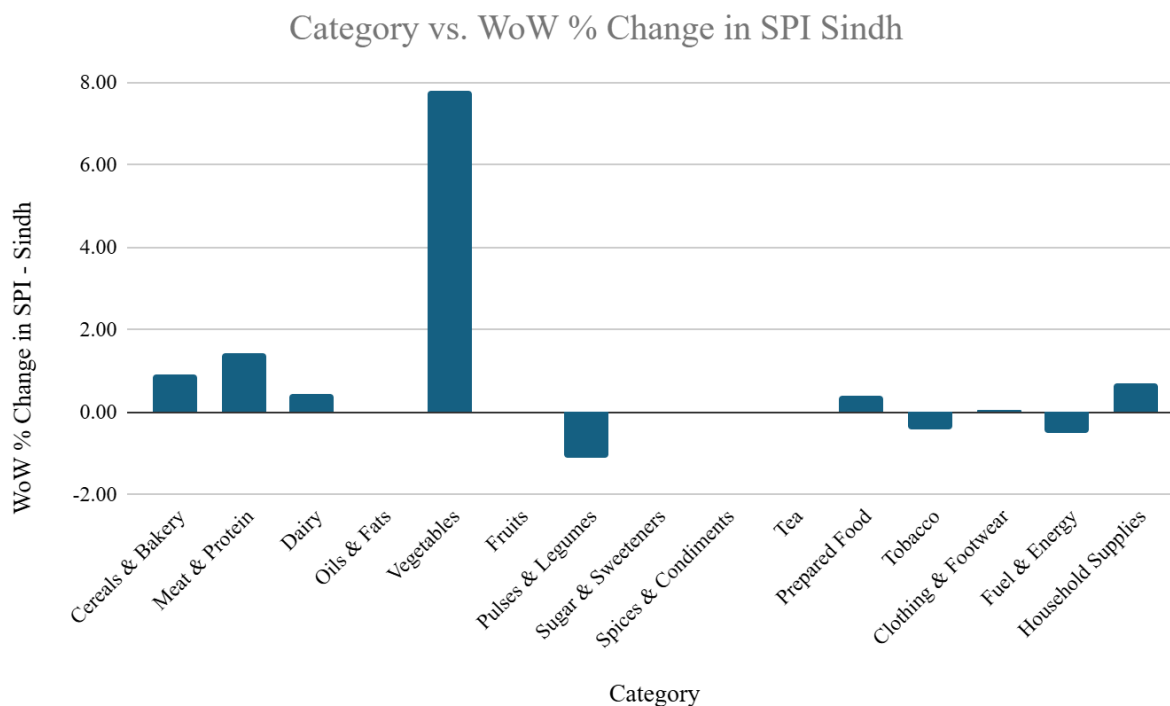
PART-II (SPI REPORT)

CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (13.08.2026 OVER 06.08.2026)

The category-wise analysis of SPI-Sindh for the week ended 13.08.2026 indicates an overall increase of 0.37 percent over the previous week. The increase was led by Vegetables (7.79%), followed by Meat & Protein (1.42%), Cereals & Bakery (0.91%), Household Supplies (0.72%), Dairy (0.43%), Prepared Food (0.40%), and Clothing & Footwear (0.05%). Decreases were recorded in Pulses & Legumes (-1.10%), Fuel & Energy (-0.51%), and Tobacco (-0.41%). Oils & Fats, Fruits, Sugar & Sweeteners, Spices & Condiments, and Tea remained unchanged (0.00%) during the week. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.

CATEGORY-WISE DIVISION LEVEL ANALYSIS (WoW)

The division-wise analysis indicates considerable regional variation in weekly price movements. At the provincial (Sindh) level, the largest increases were recorded in Vegetables (+6.2%) and Meat & Protein (+1.9%), followed by Household Supplies (+0.5%), Cereals & Bakery (+0.4%), Prepared Food (+0.4%), Dairy (+0.3%), Clothing & Footwear (+0.2%), and Oils & Fats (+0.1%).

Fruits, Sugar & Sweeteners, Spices & Condiments, and Tea remained unchanged at 0.0%. The largest decline was observed in Pulses & Legumes (-0.9%), followed by Fuel & Energy (-0.4%) and Tobacco (-0.4%).

Karachi recorded the highest increase in Vegetables (+5.5%), followed by Fruits (+1.4%), Spices & Condiments (+1.2%), and Cereals & Bakery (+1.1%). Smaller increases were observed in Meat & Protein (+0.9%), Oils & Fats (+0.5%), Pulses & Legumes (+0.4%), Clothing & Footwear (+0.3%), and Dairy, Prepared Food, and Tea (+0.1% each). The largest decline was observed in Household Supplies (-1.0%), followed by Fuel & Energy (-0.5%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.4%), and Tobacco (-0.1%).

Hyderabad registered increases in Vegetables (+4.1%), Pulses & Legumes (+0.7%), Cereals & Bakery, Oils & Fats, and Clothing & Footwear (+0.4% each), and Spices & Condiments (+0.3%). Sugar & Sweeteners and Household Supplies registered marginal increases of +0.1% each. Meat & Protein, Tea, and Prepared Food remained unchanged (0.0%). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-0.6%) and Dairy (-0.3%), followed by Fuel & Energy (-0.3%) and Tobacco (-0.2%).

Sukkur recorded substantial increases in Vegetables (+10.8%) and Household Supplies (+6.5%), followed by Fruits (+3.3%) and Dairy (+2.8%). Smaller increases were observed in Meat & Protein (+0.6%), Tea (+0.5%), Clothing & Footwear (+0.2%), and Fuel & Energy (+0.1%). Tobacco remained unchanged (0.0%). The sharpest decline was recorded in Cereals & Bakery (-6.9%), followed by Spices & Condiments (-2.1%), Pulses & Legumes (-1.9%), Prepared Food (-1.3%), Oils & Fats (-0.6%), and Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.1%).

Larkana recorded a substantial increase in Vegetables (+8.0%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (+3.2%), Meat & Protein (+3.1%), and Prepared Food (+2.4%). A marginal increase was also observed in Clothing & Footwear (+0.1%). Spices & Condiments, Tea, Tobacco, and Household Supplies remained unchanged (0.0%). The sharpest decline was observed in Fruits (-2.4%), followed by Oils & Fats (-1.3%), Fuel & Energy (-0.8%), Pulses & Legumes (-0.7%), Dairy (-0.4%), and Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.3%).

Mirpurkhas recorded substantial increases in Vegetables (+11.8%) and Household Supplies (+8.5%), followed by Meat & Protein (+7.8%) and Fruits (+5.7%). Smaller increases were observed in Oils & Fats (+0.9%), Tea (+0.6%), Spices & Condiments (+0.5%), and Dairy (+0.3%). Tobacco remained unchanged (0.0%). The sharpest decline was observed in Pulses & Legumes (-6.8%),

followed by Sugar & Sweeteners (-1.0%) and Clothing & Footwear (-1.0%), with marginal declines in Cereals & Bakery (-0.4%), Prepared Food (-0.3%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.1%).

Shaheed Benazirabad recorded the largest increase in Meat & Protein (+2.9%), followed by Vegetables (+2.2%) and Tea (+1.0%). Smaller increases were observed in Dairy and Oils & Fats (+0.6% each) and Household Supplies (+0.1%). The largest decline was observed in Tobacco (-1.7%), followed by Pulses & Legumes (-1.2%), Fruits (-1.1%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.8%), Prepared Food and Spices & Condiments (-0.7% each), Cereals & Bakery (-0.3%), Clothing & Footwear (-0.2%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.1%).

Overall, weekly price movements were primarily influenced by substantial increases in Vegetables and Meat & Protein. Vegetable prices increased across all six divisions, with the highest increases recorded in Mirpurkhas, Sukkur, and Larkana. Meat & Protein also increased across all six divisions except Hyderabad, which remained unchanged, led by Mirpurkhas, Larkana, and Shaheed Benazirabad. Fruits showed mixed regional movements, with sharp increases in Mirpurkhas and Sukkur and a smaller increase in Karachi, offset by declines in Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad, and Hyderabad. Fuel & Energy declined in all divisions except Sukkur (+0.1%). Pulses & Legumes showed mixed regional movements, with increases in Karachi (+0.4%) and Hyderabad (+0.7%), and declines across Sukkur, Larkana, and Shaheed Benazirabad, and, most sharply, Mirpurkhas (-6.8%). At the provincial level, the declines in Pulses & Legumes, Fuel & Energy, and Tobacco reflected varying regional movements across the divisions.

Category-level values represent the **unweighted arithmetic average** of commodity-level changes within each respective category.

For each division, the representative price of every commodity is calculated as the geometric mean of its district-level prices. Base prices and commodity weights are then applied to obtain weighted price relatives for the current and previous weeks.

Commodity-level week-on-week percentage changes are calculated from the current- and previous-week weighted price relatives.

The Sindh column is calculated independently using the geometric mean of prices across all 30 districts for each commodity, followed by the same weighting, week-on-week change and category-aggregation procedure. It is not calculated from the six divisional values.

CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (13.08.2026 OVER 16.07.2026)

The category-wise MoM analysis for the period ending 13.08.2026 indicates a marginal overall increase of 0.21 percent compared with 16.07.2026. The increase was led by Vegetables (16.82%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (1.78%), Dairy (1.22%), Meat & Protein (0.94%), Household Supplies (0.86%), Prepared Food (0.81%), and Oils & Fats (0.71%), which also increased during the period.

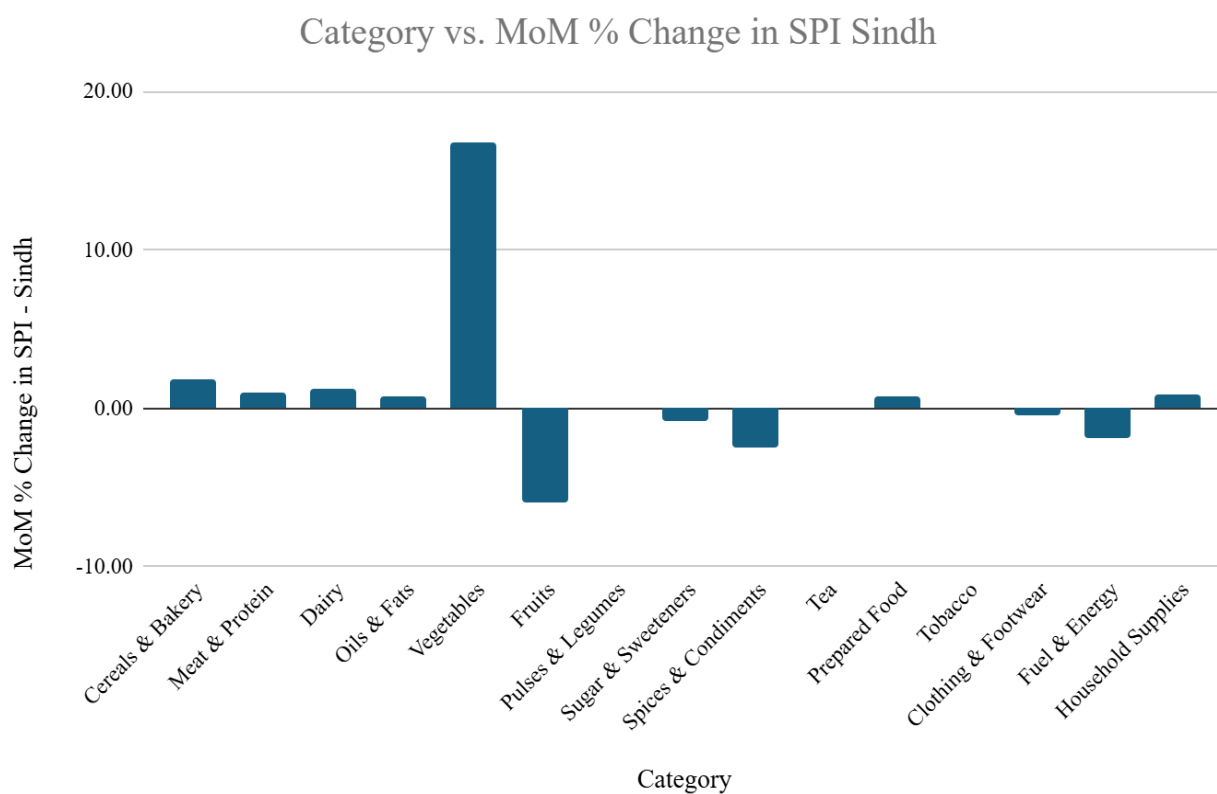
These increases were largely offset by decreases in Fruits (-5.96%), Spices & Condiments (-2.48%), Fuel & Energy (-1.88%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.77%), and Clothing & Footwear (-0.41%).

Pulses & Legumes, Tea, and Tobacco remained unchanged (0.00%) during the period. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.

¹ Category changes in Table 1 are derived from the SPI-Sindh category indices using the prescribed item weights. The division-level figures in Table 3 represent averages of commodity-level percentage changes and are therefore not directly comparable with the category-index changes reported in Table 1.
