WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

- SPI-Sindh marginally increased by 0.06% WoW and decreased by 0.51% MoM.
- Prepared food recorded the highest category increase (+1.21%), while Fruits registered the largest decline (-8.78%).
- Onions (+9.1%) and Petrol, Super (+3.7%) recorded the largest increases, while Tomatoes registered the largest decline (-15.6%), followed by Banana (-9.0%).
- SPI-Sindh calculated by SBOS using PBS price data for four major cities also increased by 0.29%.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

SENSITIVE PRICE INDEX SINDH (SPI-Sindh) FOR THE WEEK ENDED ON 20.08.2026

Sensitive Price Index of Sindh (SPI-Sindh) has been calculated on a weekly basis to observe the price changes of 50 essential items in Sindh. SPI-Sindh is based on 50 essential items and prices collected from 120 shops, 60 markets in 30 districts of Sindh (4 shops and 2 markets per district). The prices of Electricity & Gas are obtained from PBS's SPI report for the same period. The week-on-week (WoW) and month-on-month (MoM) changes in SPI-Sindh are as follows:

As a validation strategy, SPI-Sindh was cross-checked against the PBS price data for four major cities of Sindh—Karachi, Hyderabad, Sukkur and Larkana disseminated under the National SPI for the week ended on 20.08.2026. The direction of movement remained comparable and consistent. The SPI calculated by SBOS using the PBS price data for these four cities is presented below for comparison.

ANALYSIS OF SPI-SINDH:

SPI-Sindh for the current week ended on 20.08.2026 increased by 0.06 percent compared with the previous week, while on a month-on-month (MoM) basis, the index recorded a decrease of 0.51 percent. This indicates a marginal increase in the prices of essential commodities during the week while marginal decrease on MoM basis.

During the current week, an increase was observed in 23 commodities. The highest increase was recorded in Onions (+9.1%), followed by Petrol, Super (+3.7%), Tea Prepared, Average Hotel (+1.3%), Cooked Daal, Average Hotel (+1.2%), and Pulse Gram, Washed (+1.1%). Other notable increases were observed in Cooked Beef, Average Hotel (+1.1%), Gur, Average Quality (+1.0%), Bread Plain, Medium Size (+0.8%), Cooking Oil, Tin (+0.8%), Pulse Masoor, Washed (+0.8%) and

Soap, Lifebuoy (+0.8%). Moderate increases were also recorded in Pulse Mash, Washed (+0.7%), Beef with Bone, Average Quality (+0.4%), Cigarettes, K-2/Capstan, 20's (+0.4%), Energy Saver (14 watts) (+0.4%), Mutton, Average Quality (+0.3%), Curd (Dahi) (+0.3%), Georgette (+0.3%), and Sandal Bata (Ladies) (+0.3%). Marginal increases were also observed in Wheat Flour, Bag Average Quality (+0.2%), Vegetable Ghee (Loose) (+0.2%), Long Cloth (+0.2%) and Vegetable Ghee, Tin (+0.1%).

On the other hand, a decrease was recorded in 20 commodities. The largest decrease was observed in Tomatoes (-15.6%), followed by Bananas (-9.0%), Hi Speed Diesel (HSD) (-5.2%), Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live (-4.3%), Potatoes (-3.8%), Red Chilli Powder, Loose (-2.0%), and Rice Basmati Broken, Average Quality (-1.5%). Other decreases were recorded in Washing Soap, 200-250 gm (-0.9%), Rice Irri (Punjab/Sindh) (-0.8%), Pulse Moong, Washed (-0.8%), Shirting (-0.7%), LPG Cylinder, 11kg (-0.7%), Garlic (-0.6%), and Sandal Bata (Gents) (-0.5%). Marginal decreases were also recorded in Powdered Milk, Nido, Polybag (-0.4%), Eggs Hen, Farm (-0.4%), Mustard Oil, Average Quality (-0.2%), Tea, Lipton Yellow Label, Packet (-0.2%), Firewood Whole (-0.2%) and Chappal Sponge Bata (Gents) (-0.1%).

The prices of 7 commodities remained unchanged, including Milk, Fresh, Unboiled, Sugar, Refined, Salt Powder, Loose (Lahori), Lawn, Electricity Charges (Upto 50 Units), Gas Charges (Upto 3.3719 MMBTU), and Match Box (Regular).

The weekly trend reflects slightly rising price pressure from food and non-food commodities, particularly Onions, Petrol, Super, Tea Prepared, Average Hotel, and Cooked Daal, Average Hotel. These increases outweighed decreases in Tomatoes, Bananas, Hi Speed Diesel (HSP), and Chicken Farm, Broiler, Live, and selected pulse and fuel items. In contrast, the marginal MoM marginally decrease of 0.51 percent indicates that the overall price level remained broadly stable, though slightly below that recorded during the corresponding week of the previous month.

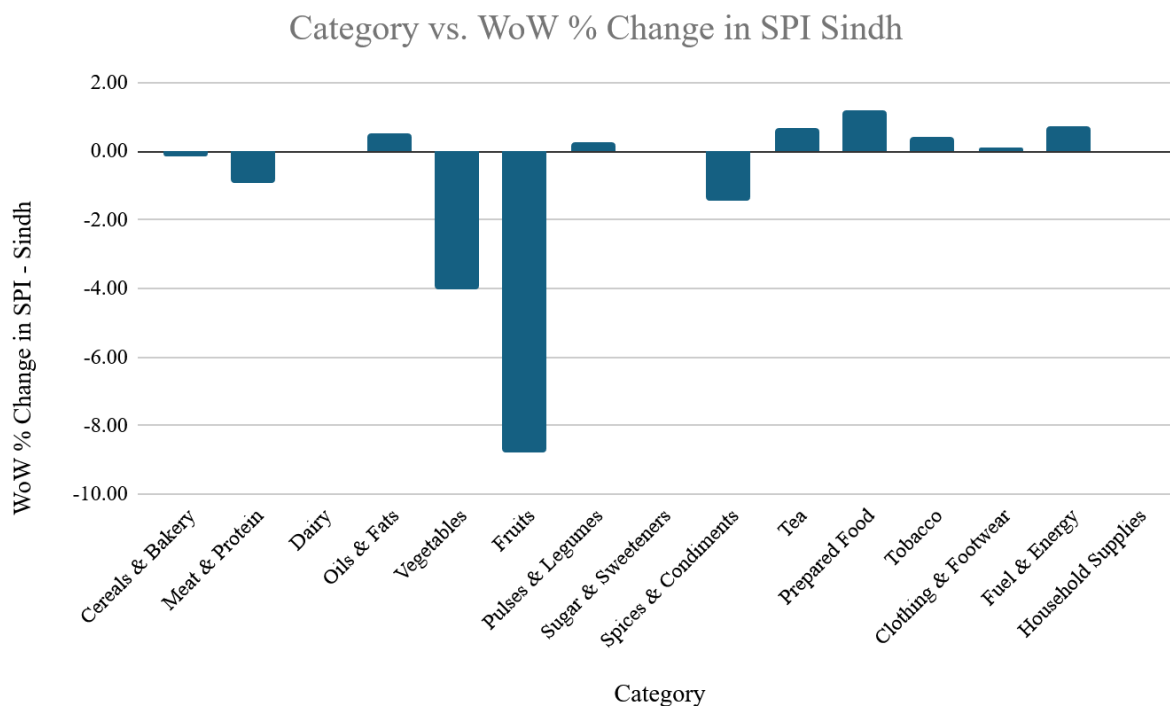
PART-II (SPI REPORT)

CATEGORY-WISE WEEKLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (20.08.2026 OVER 13.08.2026)

The category-wise analysis of SPI-Sindh for the week ended 20.08.2026 indicates an overall increase of 0.06 percent over the previous week. The increase was led by Prepared Food (1.21%), followed by Fuel & Energy (0.73%), Tea (0.70%), Oils & Fats (0.51%), Tobacco (0.41%), Pulses & Legumes (0.28%), Clothing & Footwear (0.09%) and Dairy (0.02%). Decreases were recorded in Fruits (-8.78%), Vegetables (-4.03%), Spices & Condiments (-1.45%), Meat & Protein (-0.90%), and Cereals & Bakery (-0.16%). Sugar & Sweeteners and Household Supplies remained unchanged (0.00%) during the week. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.

CATEGORY-WISE DIVISION LEVEL ANALYSIS (WoW)

The division-wise analysis indicates mixed regional price movements across categories during the week. At the provincial (Sindh) level, the largest increase was recorded in Prepared Food (+1.2%), followed by Tea (+0.6%), Tobacco (+0.4%), Household Supplies (+0.4%), Oils & Fats (+0.3%), Pulses & Legumes (+0.3%), and Dairy (+0.1%). Sugar & Sweeteners and Clothing & Footwear remained unchanged at 0.0%. The largest provincial decline was observed in Fruits (-8.8%),

followed by Vegetables (-2.6%), Cereals & Bakery (-0.7%), Spices & Condiments (-1.0%), Meat & Protein (-1.0%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.4%).

Karachi recorded increases in Vegetables (+2.2%), Oils & Fats (+1.8%), Sugar & Sweeteners (+1.4%), Household Supplies (+1.5%), and marginal increases in Dairy, Tea, and Tobacco (+0.1% each). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-4.2%), followed by Clothing & Footwear (-1.4%), Fuel & Energy (-0.7%), and Pulses & Legumes and Spices & Condiments (-0.5% each). Cereals & Bakery declined by -1.6%, while Meat & Protein remained unchanged (0.0%).

Hyderabad registered increases in Cereals & Bakery (+0.5%) and Pulses & Legumes (+0.5%), followed by Tobacco (+0.4%), Sugar & Sweeteners (+0.3%), Dairy (+0.2%), and Clothing & Footwear (+0.2%). Household Supplies increased marginally by +0.1%, while Tea and Prepared Food remained unchanged (0.0%). The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-14.4%), followed by Spices & Condiments (-2.7%), Oils & Fats (-1.6%), Fuel & Energy (-0.3%), and marginal declines in other categories.

Sukkur recorded a substantial increase in Prepared Food (+12.6%), followed by Tea (+2.1%), Pulses & Legumes (+3.6%), Spices & Condiments (+1.4%), and Oils & Fats (+0.4%). The largest decline was observed in Vegetables (-4.5%), followed by Cereals & Bakery (-3.4%), Dairy (-1.9%), Meat & Protein (-1.8%), Clothing & Footwear (-1.3%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.9%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.7%). Tobacco and Household Supplies remained unchanged at 0.0%.

Larkana recorded the sharpest decline in Fruits (-10.4%) followed by Vegetables (-9.5%), while increases were observed in Clothing & Footwear (+2.9%), Pulses & Legumes (+0.5%), Dairy (+0.2%), Tea (+0.4%), and Fuel & Energy (+0.1%). Sugar & Sweeteners and Tobacco remained unchanged (0.0%). Other notable declines were recorded in Cereals & Bakery (-0.2%), Meat & Protein (-0.2%), Spices & Condiments (-1.3%), Prepared Food (-0.9%), and Household Supplies (-1.1%).

Mirpurkhas recorded substantial declines across several major food categories. The largest decline was observed in Fruits (-23.2%), followed by Vegetables (-13.7%), Meat & Protein (-6.4%). The other notable decline was observed in Tea (-1.0%), Clothing & Footwear (-1.1%), Household Supplies (-0.9%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.2%), Prepared Food (-0.3%), and Fuel & Energy (-0.5%). Whereas increase was recorded in Pulses & Legumes (+2.0%), Oils & Fats (+1.5%), Spices & Condiments (+1.0%), and Tobacco (+0.7%). Dairy remained unchanged (0.0%).

Shaheed Benazirabad recorded notable increases in Vegetables (+4.2%), Prepared Food (+1.9%), Tobacco (+1.7%), and Sugar & Sweeteners (+0.6%), followed by Dairy (+0.3%), Cereals & Bakery (+0.6%), Tea (+0.1%), and marginal movements in other categories. The largest decline was observed in Meat & Protein -1.1%, followed by Household Supplies (-0.2%), Oils & Fats (-0.2%), Fuel & Energy (-0.3%), and Pulses & Legumes (-0.1%). Fruits, Spices & Condiments and Clothing & Footwear remained unchanged (0.0%).

Overall, weekly price movements were characterized by sharp declines in Fruits and Vegetables at the provincial level, while Prepared Food, Tea, Tobacco, Household Supplies, and Oils & Fats recorded provincial increases. Fruit prices declined in all divisions except Shaheed Benazirabad, with the sharpest decline in Mirpurkhas (-23.2%), followed by Hyderabad (-14.4%) and Larkana

(-10.4%). Vegetable prices increased in Karachi, Hyderabad, and Shaheed Benazirabad, but declined sharply in Sukkur, Larkana, and Mirpurkhas, with the largest decrease in Mirpurkhas (-13.7%). Prepared Food showed highly divergent regional movements, increasing sharply in Sukkur (+12.6%) and Shaheed Benazirabad (+1.9%), while declining in Larkana, Mirpurkhas, and Karachi. Pulses & Legumes generally recorded modest increases, led by Sukkur (+3.6%) and Mirpurkhas (+2.0%), while Karachi and Shaheed Benazirabad recorded marginal declines. Fuel & Energy declined in all divisions except Larkana (+0.1%). The overall provincial decline in Fruits, Vegetables, Meat & Protein, and Spices & Condiments was therefore driven by substantial decreases in selected divisions, particularly Mirpurkhas, Larkana, and Hyderabad.

Category-level values represent the **unweighted arithmetic average** of commodity-level changes within each respective category.

For each division, the representative price of every commodity is calculated as the geometric mean of its district-level prices. Base prices and commodity weights are then applied to obtain weighted price relatives for the current and previous weeks.

Commodity-level week-on-week percentage changes are calculated from the current- and previous-week weighted price relatives.

The Sindh column is calculated independently using the geometric mean of prices across all 30 districts for each commodity, followed by the same weighting, week-on-week change and category-aggregation procedure. It is not calculated from the six divisional values.

CATEGORY-WISE MONTHLY PRICE MOVEMENT IN SPI-SINDH (20.08.2026 OVER 23.07.2026)

The category-wise MoM analysis for the period ending 20.08.2026 indicates a marginal overall decrease of 0.51 percent compared with 23.07.2026. The decrease was led by Fruits (-14.22%), followed by Spices & Condiments (-2.87%), Fuel & Energy (-2.11%), Sugar & Sweeteners (-0.77%), Pulses & Legumes (-0.55%), and Clothing & Footwear (-0.14%), which also decreased during the period.

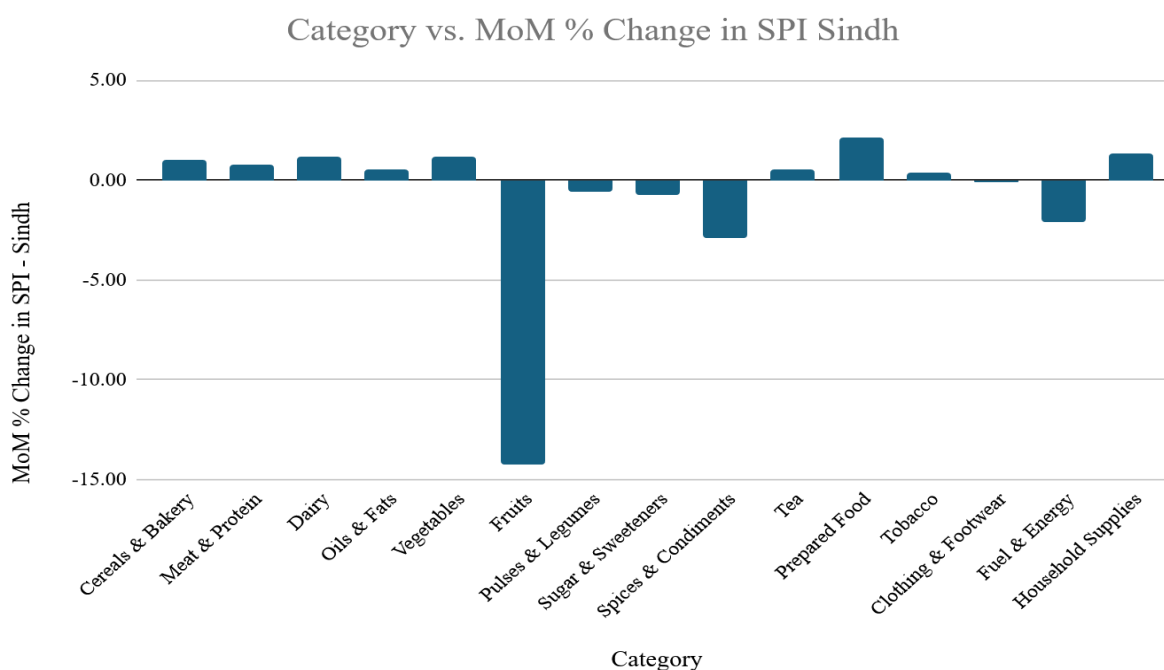
¹ Category changes in Table 1 are derived from the SPI-Sindh category indices using the prescribed item weights. The division-level figures in Table 3 represent averages of commodity-level percentage changes and are therefore not directly comparable with the category-index changes reported in Table 1.

These decreases were largely offset by increases in Prepared Food (2.17%), Household Supplies (1.3%), Dairy (1.2%), Vegetables (1.15%), Cereals & Bakery (1.02%), Meat & Protein (0.77%), Tea (0.56%), Oils & Fats (0.51%), and Tobacco (0.41%).

No category remained unchanged (0.00%) during the period. The detailed list of commodities included under each category is provided at Annex-A.
