Applications are invited from eligible **female candidates** for the following contractual position required for the implementation of the **Sindh Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (SMICS) 2026–27**, to be conducted by the Sindh Bureau of Statistics (SBoS) in collaboration with UNICEF Pakistan.

TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES

- ▶ Train Supervisors, Enumerators and Measurers to ensure high-standard data quality as per MICS protocols.
- ▶ Monitor data collection activities, including water quality testing and anthropometry measurement procedures, and ensure that results are accurately recorded and properly captured in the CAPI application.
- ▶ Vigorously check filled questionnaires, identify errors, and immediately report to the designated officer in the Bureau of Statistics.
- ▶ Coordinate with field teams to locate them in the assigned clusters where they are working and provide technical support and guidance to field teams during data collection.
- ▶ Liaise with local government authorities, community leaders, and union council representatives to facilitate smooth entry and cooperation of households during data collection.
- ▶ Observe Vehicle Logs and ensure they are properly maintained, trips are duly recorded, and vehicles are used exclusively for survey-related activities.
- ▶ Track fieldwork progress and prepare and submit daily end-of-cluster reports summarizing completion status, provide technical support to data collection team, data quality observations (Survey protocols, accuracy and completeness of interviews, consistency checks, identified errors etc.), and any pending issues before teams proceed to the next cluster.
- ▶ Perform any other duties assigned from time to time by the SBoS management.

QUALIFICATION & EXPERIENCE

- ▶ **Education & Experience:** 16 years of education preferably in Statistics, Economics, Mathematics, Business Administration or equivalent with one year experience in Supervision / Monitoring in large data collection assignment
- ▶ **OR:** 14 year of education preferably in Statistics, Economics, Mathematics, Business Administration or equivalent with two year experience in Supervision / Monitoring in large data collection assignment

- ▶ **Preference:** Prior experience in MICS, PDHS, PSLM, or any large-scale household survey will be an added advantage. The interviewers will preferably be selected from local residents of the respective divisions and should be willing and able to travel across the province as required.
